The Council for the past several years has served the University faculty by supporting the publications of works that otherwise would not be able to be completed without financial assistance .

The following works have had subvention:

Florida Sinkholes by Prof. Robert Brinkmann, published by the University of Florida Press
Amount for subvention: \$5000 for developing maps and figures for the publication

Mesoamerican Ritual Economy: Archaeological and Ethnological Perspectives. By Prof. Christian Wells
University Press of Colorado Proofreading/indexing \$1550.

Crucial Issues in Caribbean Religions Prof. Mozella Mitchell
\$4000. Peter Lang Publishing Company.

Money, Invisibility and American Literature 1945-2007 Prof Michael Clune, Cambridge University Press
\$1200 – for cover art work and reprinting permission

Pioneer Commercial Photography: The Burgert Brothers, Tampa Prof. Robert Snyder \$4980 for
reprinting with additional materials by the Florida Historical Society Press.

Yale Anthology of Younger American Poetry Jay Hopley , Yale University Press \$7500 for 15% of the
cost to manufacture the publication. Without this subsidy, Yale could not publish the book.

A Chain of Kings: The Makassarese Chronicles of Gowa and Talloq Prof. William Cummings published
by KITLV. Subvention \$1485. for the cost of the maps .

The requesting faculty members are responsible for donating 2 copies of their publication to the Tampa
Library.
