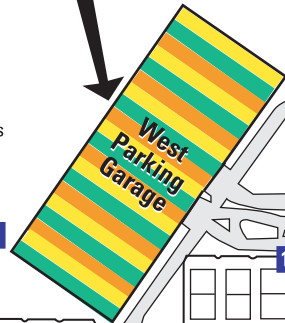

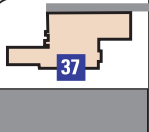
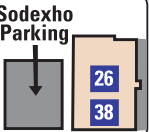
CAMPUS PARKING KEY
